

St Croix Falls Public Library Service Level Framework According to Polk County COVID-19 Activity Level

The St Croix Falls Public Library uses the Polk County COVID-19 dashboard (<https://arcg.is/1bmeOm>) to determine the activity level in our area. This is intended to be a flexible framework that may be adjusted as more information becomes available. The St Croix Falls Public Library uses information from the DPI, IFLS, Governor’s Office, Polk County Health and other Library Directors when determining services offered.

Occupancy limits are based on the square footage available for public use, including a 6’ social distancing requirement and mask wearing requirement. To maintain proper social distancing recommendations, the maximum capacity will not exceed 25% of what it normally is. Other factors may become important too, for example the activity level in Polk County, upward trends, and recent outbreaks among our library staff or infections that may have occurred in the building. As long as Polk County reflects a “Covid-19” Level, Covid-19 Specific library policies will remain in effect. Once Covid-19 Levels are no longer registered in Polk County, the library will open its doors to unrestricted use.
