

- 2 Strips From a Twizzler Pull & Peel
- 2 Pretzel Rods
- 1 Teaspoon of Peanut Butter
- 1 Gummy Worm (optional)
- 8-12 Goldfish Crackers and/or Mini Swedish Fig.
- 1 Packet of Blue Jello (optional)
- 1 Clear Cup or Container (optional)



First, make the "water".

- 1. With help from an adult, follow the directions on the Jello box and prepare the Jello.
- 2. After the Jello is cooked, pour it into a clear plastic cup or container and put it aside until it gels. This will take an hour or more.
- 3. Optional: You can buy Jello already made and scoop it into your cup. Don't worry if you don't have Jello. You can also "go fishing" on a paper plate.

Next, make the fishing rods.

- 4. Peel two strips from a single Pull & Peel Twizzler.
- 5. Approximately 1" from the end of a pretzel rod spread a ½ inch ring of peanut butter. The peanut butter will be the glue that connects your "fishing line" to your "fishing pole".
- 6. Wrap one end of a Twizzler strip twice around the peanut butter ring on the pole. Your pole should now have two rings of Twizzler strip over the peanut butter ring. The Twizzler will stick to the rod better if it is wrapped as tightly as possible and if the Twizzler rings touch each other. You may need to use extra peanut butter if you need more glue. This is your "fishing line".

Then, make the bait.

7. Wrap the other end of the Twizzler strip around a Mini Swedish Fish or a Goldfish Cracker. You may want to use peanut butter as glue to hold the cracker in place. This is your "bait".

Finally, put it all together!

- 8. After your Jello is completely gelled, cover the top with a layer of Goldfish Crackers and Mini Swedish Fish. These are the fish swimming in the water.
- 9. Put a dab of peanut butter on the "bait" so the fish swimming in the water will stick to the bait if they touch.
- 10. Go fishing! Invite a friend to go fishing and see who can catch the most fish!
